Missing for 29 days in Miami, FL... GG is now SAFE & HOME!!!

Here is GG's story, told by her owner Matthew.

On July 10th my dog of 8 years, GG, ran out of my apartment from NW 7th Ave in Miami, FL. I received a phone call from my girlfriend informing me that GG was not in the apartment and asked if I had her with me. Two hours had passed and I desperately drove around the area in hopes she would hear me calling her name. I made fliers and even had friends join me in the search.

On July 14th I was referred to PI Jamie Katz, she had a good reputation with many people and I decided to go with her services. Within a few hours of contacting Jamie, I was running behind her and her scent hounds. The dogs showed us GG's direction of travel and then created a perimeter of GG's scent. The perimeter told us how far GG's scent went in each direction, north, east, south and west. Jamie then mapped out the trails her tracking dogs had scent and I posted signs based off her mapping so no one could come in or out of the area without seeing GG's lost dog sign. The phone calls started coming in within 24 hours and I was having sightings of all the dogs in my area that looked similar to GG, this really helped me regain hope that I had already lost. Jamie maintained communication with me on a daily basis and kept my moral up.

On August 6, Toni Garcia saw a post of a dog that looked like GG that had just been brought into Miami Dade Animal Shelter. As soon as I opened Jamie's text, I knew it was GG. MDAS was already closed but I was first in line at the shelter the next morning. I showed identification to prove who I was and because GG had only been at the shelter for less than 24 hours, I did not have to pay any fees. I was reunited with GG and we were back home together within hours. I am beyond satisfied with the services provided by PI Jamie Katz and I definitely recommend her services to anyone who has a missing family member. Thank you again to all that helped and of course a big thank you to Toni Garcia for seeing the MDAS post and bringing it to Jamie's attention. My family is back together and there is nothing better!
